How to Check Microphone and Record Audio

Checking Microphone and Recording Audio on Windows:

- 1. Checking if Microphone is Connected:
 - Open Sound Settings:
 - Right-click on the speaker icon in the system tray (bottom-right corner of the screen).
 - Select 'Sound settings.'



2. Check Microphone:

- In the Sound settings window, scroll down to 'Input.'
- You should see your microphone listed under 'Choose your input device.'

If you cannot see your microphone listed here or are unable to record your voice, please check if your microphone is properly connected and ensure all necessary drivers are installed.

- Press Windows key and type 'Voice Recorder.'
- Click on the 'Voice Recorder' app to open it



2. Record Your Voice:

- Click the microphone icon to start recording.
